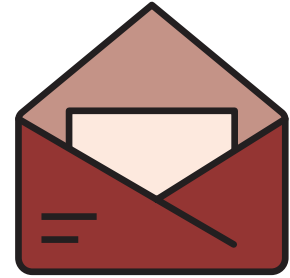

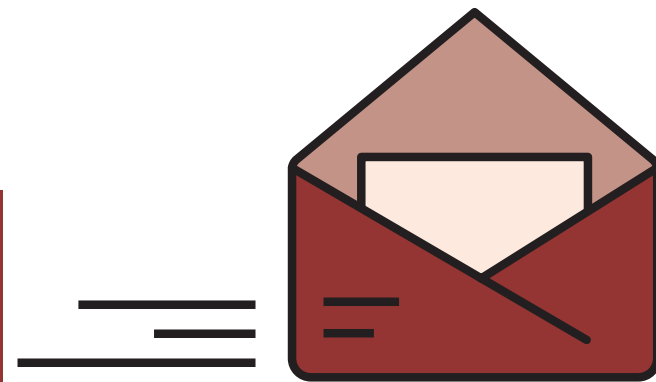

BY MAIL IN THE JUNE 23 PRIMARY

For the first time, all registered voters in Kentucky can vote absentee by mail for the **June 23 Primary**. Absentee voting by mail is convenient, safe and secure. Voting absentee by mail is easy; follow these simple steps:

Request your absentee ballot by visiting <https://vrsws.sos.ky.gov/abrweb/>. Absentee ballots may also be obtained from your county clerk, in person or by phone, fax or email.

When you receive your ballot, select your candidates for office, then return it as soon as possible. **Mailed ballots must be received** at your local county clerk's office by **6PM on Tuesday, June 23**.
